FHN lactation consultants are all International Board-Certified Lactation Consultants (IBCLC). This is the highest accredited healthcare professional specializing in lactation. They work together with mothers, families, and society to provide expert breastfeeding and lactation care.

They are trained to help with a variety of issues with breastfeeding including the most common ones such as latching issues, low milk supply, engorgement, breast infections, pumping, and breast/nipple pain.

They function and contribute as members of the maternal child health team and provide care in a variety of settings, while making appropriate referrals to other health professionals and community support resources.

When referring to FHN Lactation Consultants.

- It is recommended that patients have a referral from their PCP, Ob/Gyn, or Pediatrician but is not required. Patients will be contacted by one of the four lactation consultants within 24 to 48 hours
- Patients can decide to meet or speak with a lactation consultant prior to having their baby if desired
- FHN also offers a breastfeeding class on the 1st Tuesday of every other month by one of our lactation consultants. Patients may register for class at **fhn.org/ob**
